• Hoot like a Great Horned Owl.

• Jump up in a crowded area and shout "I love birds" three times.

• Turn your shirt around backward and wear your binoculars backward for 5 minutes, too. See if you get any funny looks. (You will.)

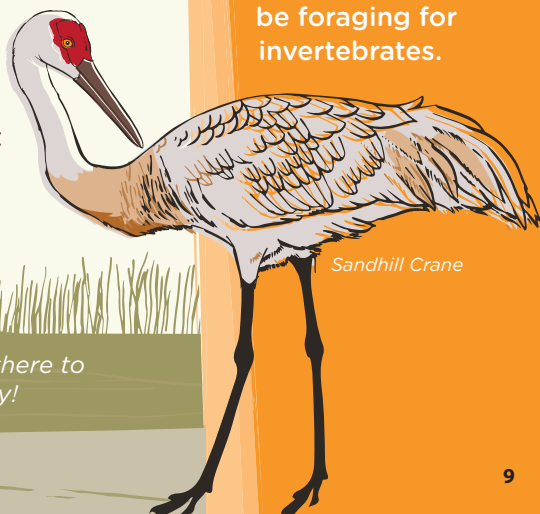
** Make sure you have someone there to catch you in case you get dizzy!*

BIRD Facts

SANDHILL CRANES

When nesting, Sandhill Cranes are pretty territorial, and you'll only see a couple together at a time—sometimes more if they have young. However, during winter and migration, they will flock together in groups of thousands.

Look for cranes in fields, along water, or in marshes. In the fields, they'll be looking for grain to eat, and in the marshes, they'll be foraging for invertebrates.
